Fara Heim. Going Home.



The Expedition of the Millennium



PURPOSE OF THE FARA HEIM EXPEDITION:

“Að fara heim” in old Norse means *“Going Home”*... a natural trait of the human race. While the Viking Age Norse left their homes to explore the world over a 1000 years ago—leaving their mark throughout Europe and discovering a continent now known as North America—this Expedition will re-trace the routes once travelled through the Canadian Arctic... in reverse!

This 2013 **Voyage of Discovery** will search for evidence of the early Norse presence beginning in Hudson Bay, believed by many to have been penetrated by Vikings of old on their quest for discovery into the heart of the continent, and continue into the Hudson Strait, through the Canadian Arctic to Greenland and back to Iceland and Norway.

Using modern technologies the team will search these regions from Lake Winnipeg, into Hudson Bay and through the Arctic, using defined protocols to protect both the sites and the environment.
