Canadian explorers re-write North American Viking history in new series debuting on Super Channel Quest January 4

A Canadian family is starring in *Quest for the Lost Vikings*, a new documentary travel series about modern day explorers on a mission to discover the truth about their Viking heritage. The series debuts with the first two episodes shown back-to-back on Super Channel Quest on January 4th at 7pm CST with future international distribution on Viasat.

As Fellows of the world-famous Explorers Club and The Royal Canadian Geographical Society, Winnipeggers Johann Sigurdson, David Collette, and Mackenzie Collette grew up listening to stories about their Viking ancestors living in North America over 1,000 years ago.

Their years of research revealed there may have been Viking trade and travel for another 500 years before Columbus “discovered” America and now the team is taking their experience to uncover the truth about Viking exploration of the Americas. What they discover may re-write history.

“We have been on an epic adventure that’s taken us from Nunavut to the fabled Kensington Runestone in Minnesota to determine whether a lost Viking voyage made it further inland 500 years earlier than is documented,” says Johann. “We’ve found things that even we were shocked to find.”

Using the most modern technology ever taken on a quest for lost Vikings, the team takes viewers to remote places under extreme conditions to uncover artifacts and stories that may change what historians believe they know about Viking occupation in North America.

The 8-episode series was filmed over 12 months by Farpoint Films.
